

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

An improvement plan is generated to address such issues and is reviewed monthly.
- 2 To minimise, reuse and recycle waste where possible.
- 3 To take all steps, as reasonably practicable, to prevent pollution originating from our operations.
- 4 To continually review ways of reducing environmental impact of vehicles by the regular maintenance of engines and reviewing alternative power sources
- 5 To use energy and water efficiently.
- 6 This policy will be subject to annual review and be communicated to all interested parties including personnel.
